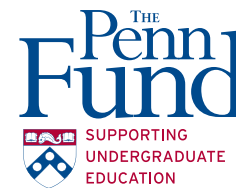


Class Honor Roll 2005-2006

Gifts to The Penn Fund support all areas of the University that contribute to undergraduate education – financial aid, special academic initiatives, classroom and residential enhancements, and student life.

By annually demonstrating their commitment to the University, over 26,000 alumni participate in the growth and success of their prestigious alma mater. Annual gifts from a growing number of alumni, parents and friends also contribute to the University's ranking as one of the premier universities in the nation.

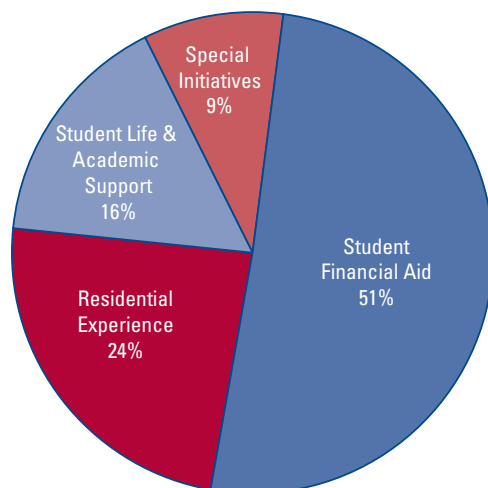
Gifts made today to The Penn Fund directly benefit the current and future generations of Penn students who will carry forward all that Penn stands for tomorrow.

Penn's \$5 billion endowment ranks 12th among colleges and universities. But when considered in terms of endowment per student, Penn drops to 71st place. The University depends heavily upon its operating budget to fund undergraduate education, which is why annual gifts to The Penn Fund are so critical.

Resource Allocation for Penn Fund Gifts

Your gifts have an impact in the lives of Penn's current undergraduate students. The following chart illustrates how Penn Fund Gifts are allocated.

- **Special Initiatives** - funds projects such as the addition of the computer labs to Penn's College House System
- **Student Financial Aid** - 40% of all undergraduate students need grant aid
- **Residential Experience** - funds renovations and upgrades to the Quad and Hamilton Village
- **Student Life & Academic Support** - supports innovative programs such as the Center for Undergraduate and Fellowships
