# GUEST GUIDE -- For the Class of 1968 50<sup>th</sup> Reunion:

**Information tents:** Located at campus entrances at the intersections of 34<sup>th</sup> and 36<sup>th</sup> Streets and Walnut Street. Stop here if you need any assistance finding anything, or for special needs requests. Friday and Saturday from 9 AM – 4 PM.



Make the **Registration Tent** your **FIRST STOP** to get your **LANYARD NAME TAG** - If you **pre-paid** for the Reunion Package or for single /a la Carte events or need to pay for an event. **You will receive your tote bag HERE.** Whether you purchased the Full Reunion Package or the just Picnic Pass, you will need to check-in at the registration tent (behind Sweeten Alumni House) to get your pass.

**NOTE:** Lanyard tags are not needed for free events.

- **Registration Tent Location** is 36 Street, 250 South Locust Walk, Patio area next to Psi Upsilon Fraternity House (the Castle), just behind the LOVE Statue on **COLLEGE GREEN**
- **Hours are Friday: 11 AM – 10 PM & Saturday: 8 AM - 10 PM.** This is where you will receive your lanyard to gain access to all the Class of 1968 registered and paid events. And the only place to get the Penn Alumni Canvas tote bag, your registration tote bag.



**Classmates – Please pick up Custom REUNION Nametags, Reunion Book, Penn68 Cap/visor and Class At-A-Glance, on Friday, May 11, from 11 AM-9 PM at the 1968 Welcome Center in The ARCH (3601 Locust Walk, room 108, first floor) On Saturday & Sunday these items will be available at all Class events.**



**Class of '68 Yearbook Nametags will help us identify each other after 50 years!** On Friday Nametags will be distributed at The Welcome Center in The ARCH from 11 AM – 6 PM and at the Friday night Party (6-9 PM). On Saturday get your nametag at the Breakfast to be held in conjunction with the Faculty Reunion and the Breakfast of Champions at Houston Hall or at the 50th Reunion Picnic Tent on College Green (12:30-3:30 PM). Nametags will be available at the 50th Reunion Gala at the Barnes (7-9 PM) and at Sunday's Breakfast in Houston Hall (10AM – NOON).

*(Note: if you didn't pre-register by May 4 you may not receive a yearbook nametag. If you have a Yearbook nametag, please wear this nametag throughout the weekend. There are no replacements.)*

**YOU CAN NOT PICK UP YOUR YEARBOOK NAMETAG AT CENTRAL REGISTRATION –It is only available for pick up at the class events noted above. Note: Your Yearbook nametag does not replace your Alumni Weekend Pass (pictured at the top of the page).**

**Our Parade costume is a Penn '68 hat (or a visor) for those who pre-registered for one.** Get your hat (one per person) when you pick up your Yearbook nametag (at Welcome Center on Friday and class events).



**The Class Picture will be taken on Saturday at 2:15 PM:** The Class of 1968 will take our 50th Reunion photo on the steps of Furness Building (Fisher Fine Arts Library) – just steps away from our Picnic Tent. **Please be on time.** The photo will take about a half hour.

Alumni can use of **David Pottruck Health and Fitness Center** free of charge. The Pottruck Center, located at 3701 Walnut Street, and is open for alumni access from 8 AM to 8 PM Friday through Sunday. You will need to present an ID and verbally advise the Allied Guard that you are part of our Alumni Weekend. Unfortunately, Pottruck Center does not have lockers available for use overnight. The lockers are for temporary day use only, so you will need to bring a personal lock, and then remove the lock when you leave the facility. Nothing can be stored in these lockers overnight.

**Kosher and Special Meal requests:** If you notified Penn Alumni Relations in your registration about any dietary requests please check with the event staff at the venue, when you arrive and they will assist you. There are vegetarian options at every event

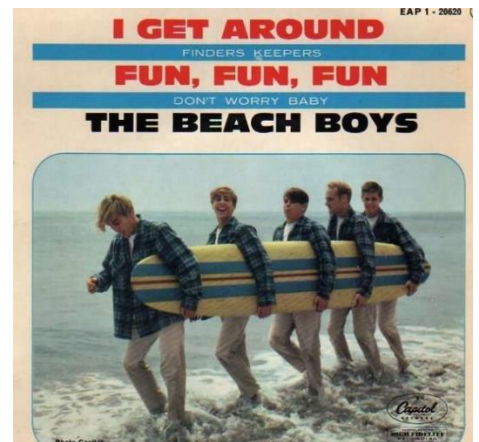
## PARKING AND TRANSPORTATION:

**Parking** is available on lots throughout campus but is very limited. Closest Lots are 38<sup>th</sup> & Walnut Street and 34<sup>th</sup> & Chestnut Street lots ([CLICK HERE](#)). In and out privileges are not available. Phone numbers are posted on the entrance to each garage in case the lot is closed after a late-night event.

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## Golf Cart needs:

The Golf Cart dispatch number is 215.827.9525 if you need assistance when you arrive on campus or after a campus event. The Golf Cart Dispatch will begin on Friday May 11.

Times: Friday 10 AM – 10 PM, Saturday 8:30 AM – 8 PM, and Sunday 8:30 AM – 3 PM.

If you need transport assistance, we recommend parking at the garage on **38th and Walnut** (next to Pottruck Gym). When you park, please call the golf cart dispatch number and they will pick you up at this parking garage and bring you onto campus.

Campus security rules for golf carts have become stricter for safety reasons and can only take you inside Locust Walk (see below).

## GOLF CART ROUTE

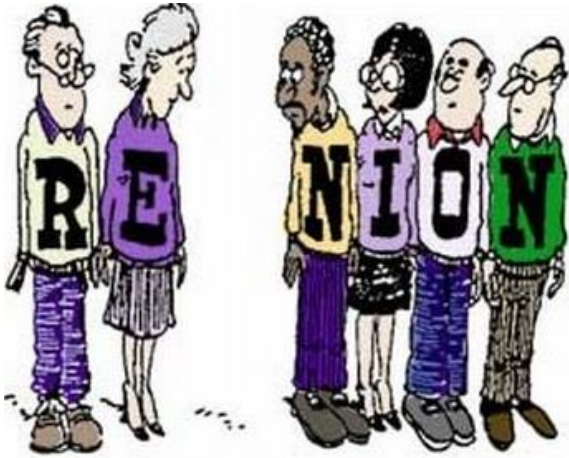


Golf carts can travel on campus between 40th and 34th, and between Spruce and Walnut Streets.

Carts cannot cross 40th, 34th, Walnut or Spruce Streets.

\*With the exception of dropping off at the parking garage next to Pottruck Center on 37th street.\*

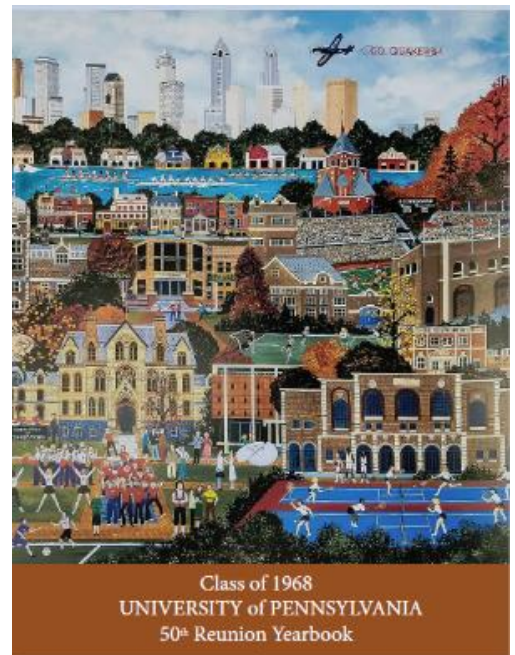
