For **special needs and handicapped accessible information on campus**-please stop by any of the Information tents. , The tents are located at campus entrances at the intersections of 34th and 36th Streets and Walnut Street. Stop here for lost and found, location assistance, or for any special needs

requests. **Info tents are open Friday and Saturday from 9 AM – 4 PM.**

Registration - Where should I go first?

If you are attending a PAID event make the All Alumni Registration Tent your FIRST STOP!

Registration Tent Location is behind Sweeten Alumni House, 3533 Locust Walk. Enter on 36th Street. Hours are Friday May 17, 11 AM – 10 PM & Saturday May 18, 8 AM - 10 PM.



At Registration, you will get your LANYARD REGISTRATION NAMETAG and Penn Alumni Insulated Tote bag.

Whether you purchased the Full Reunion Package or just the Picnic Pass, you will need to check-in at the registration tent (behind Sweeten Alumni House) to get your pass to all events.

Again, **stop here if you pre-paid** for the Reunion Package or for single /a la carte event or **if you still need to pay for an event.**

You will need your Penn Alumni Weekend Lanyard Nametag to attend all paid events – *most importantly the picnic on College Green.*

Reminder: Lanyard Registration Nametags are not needed for free events.



You will only receive the Penn Alumni Insolated Tote Bag if you visit **Registration**. This is your registration gift!

Our Class Favor (the hat or visor) pictured below, is not distributed at Registration. See below to learn where you can pick it up,

Just to be clear, the Registration tent is where you will receive your lanyard to gain access to all the Class of 1969 registered and paid events. And, the **only** place to receive the

Penn Alumni Insolated Tote Bag, your registration gift.



Not to worry - Classmates arriving late on Friday, May 17 may check in at the Gala Dinner, Union League, but will need to visit Registration behind Sweeten Alumni House, 3533 Locust Walk to receive the Penn Alumni Canvas tote bag and nametag lanyard *BEFORE* the picnic!

Note: Your Yearbook Photo Nametag does not replace your Alumni Weekend Pass (your pass is on your Lanyard you receive at Registration).

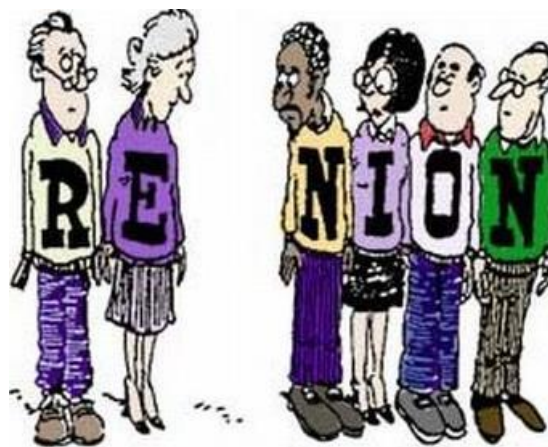
Attire - what do I wear to look sharp?

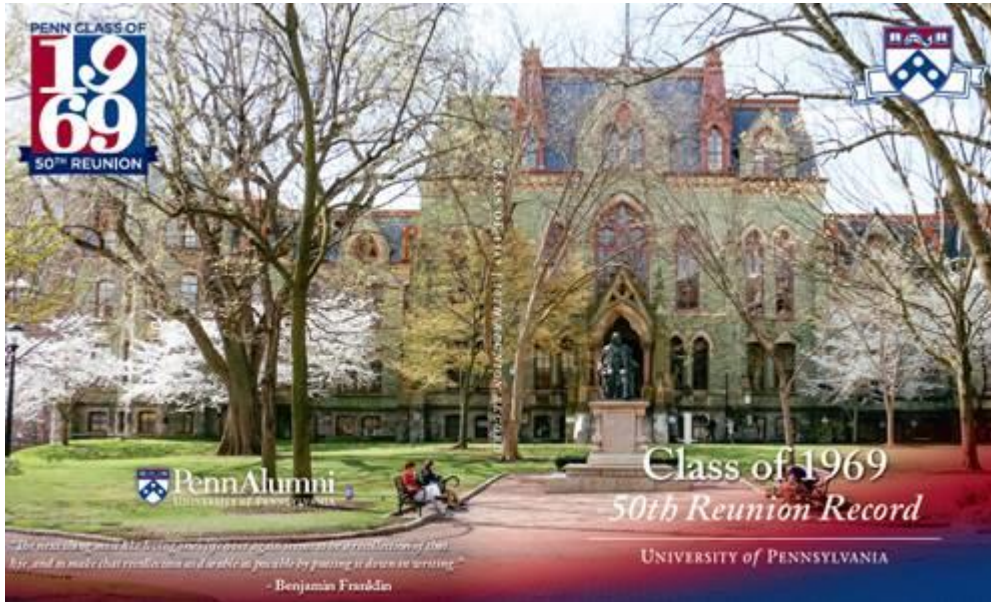
PARKING AND TRANSPORTATION - How do I get around?

- Parking is available on lots throughout campus but is very limited. The closest lots are 38th & Walnut Street and 34th & Chestnut Street lots or Penn Museum lot ([CLICK HERE](#)). In and out privileges are not available. Phone numbers are posted on the entrance to each garage in case the lot is closed after a late-night event.
- SEPTA: Public transportation is another great way to get to and from campus! SEPTA buses are free for senior citizens and the trains to suburbs cost \$1.00. Show ID if requested.

Hotel Shuttles: There are limited timed shuttles to bring you to and from campus from Downtown Marriott / Sonesta throughout the weekend. The shuttle schedules will be distributed at the hotels below. Look for the Penn Transit bus. [Click Here](#) for the full shuttle schedule.

Golf Cart needs: Golf Carts are reserved for guests with special needs. If you need special services during the weekend, you will be able to request help at the Penn Alumni Weekend Info Tents located at the 34th & Walnut and 36th & Walnut entrances to campus, or tell event staff at individual events. They will contact golf cart or ADA dispatch for you. Due to liability and risk management concerns, passenger golf carts will no longer be allowed to travel on any city sidewalk or street. As a result, passenger golf cart service for alumni during Alumni Weekend will be restricted to daylight hours for only Locust Walk between 34th and 40th Streets, and the short north/south pedestrian routes of 39th, 37th, and 36th Streets between Walnut and Spruce streets. For those needing assistance for parties, we will have special needs golf carts available upon request. **Contact your Staff Liaison (Lisbethw@upenn.edu) ahead of the Reunion with any specific requests. This will help the Golf Cart dispatch prepare for your visit!**
