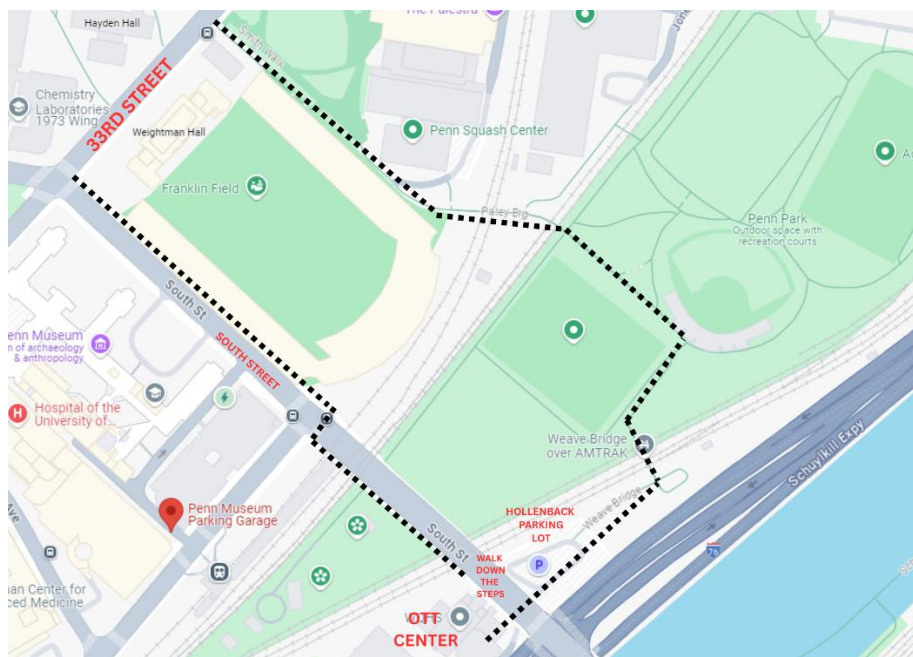

How do I get to the Ott Center?

The easiest way to get to the Ott Center is by SEPTA. The Penn Medicine University City Station is the closest SEPTA Regional Rail stop to the Ott Center, located just a short walk away. This station is serviced by the Airport, Wilmington/Newark, and Media/Elwyn lines, providing a direct connection from various areas, including 30th Street Station, Center City, the Philadelphia International Airport, and the suburbs.

Walking from Franklin Field – Walk east on South Street along Franklin Field. Cross South Street at the traffic light at Convention Avenue. Continue east on South Street until you reach the Hollenback Center. Take exterior stairwell down to River Fields Drive to enter the main entrance.

Walking From Penn Park – Take Weave Bridge near Hamlin Tennis Center over the train tracks to Hollenback/River Fields Drive. Walk along River Fields Drive to the main entrance.



Parking

Penn Museum Garage at South Street & Convention Avenue (available after 8am) and Penn Park lot at 31st and Lower Walnut Streets. On-campus parking information and maps can be found [here](#).

Additional off-campus parking is available at Cira South Garage located at 129 S. 30th Street. This garage is accessible from Walnut Street with a walkway to the Ott Center through Penn Park.

There is no bus access permitted onto River Fields Drive, via University Avenue, to access the Ott Center.

ADA Access and Parking

There will be a limited number of accessible parking spaces available in the Hollenback lot on a first-come, first-served basis. Vehicles with ADA placards will be permitted down River Fields Drive to park (if spots available) or to drop off ADA patrons. Parkers must pay for lot pass at kiosk. ADA patrons can enter via the ramp connection between the Hollenback building and the Ott Center.

During Alumni Weekend, an accessible shuttle from campus will be available. Please call 215-898-RIDE, Option 2, to schedule a pick-up/drop-off.
