Session Description: There are many pressing issues facing higher education leaders today. The tension between the expectation for free expression and the commitment to creating safe learning environments is among the most challenging. This panel will explore the pressure between these issues through the perspectives and expertise of three seasoned leaders with experience inside and outside of higher education. Panelists will explore the legal protections and limits of free expression and will share stories of their own challenges in managing the complexities between these two painstakingly held higher education values. Participants will be asked to discuss the significant intricacies involved with handling incidents of hate and bias, responding to student activism, and managing the appearance of controversial speakers, among other issues.
