RINGLING MUSEUM PROGRAM WITH CURATOR DR. DAVID BERRY

Join us for a special luncheon and curator talk at the Muse Restaurant at The John & Mabel Ringling Museum of Art with Dr. David Berry, Assistant Director of Academic Affairs. Following the lunch program, Dr. Berry will lead the Penn Club on an optional gallery tour.

Dr. Berry teaches courses on museum studies at Florida State University and museum history at the New College of Florida. He consults at the Marie Selby Botanical Gardens where he recently curated an exhibition of highlights from the research collections. Dr. Berry studied and received

his doctoral degree from Oxford University (UK).

In his talk, Dr. Berry will give us a brief history of The Ringling Museum and highlights of the new exhibit: *A Feast for the Senses: Art and Experience in Medieval Europe*. Following lunch, he will lead us on an optional Museum tour of the newly re-installed permanent galleries. After a short introduction, he will leave us at the new exhibit to explore on our own.

The new exhibition which opens in early February was curated by the Walters Museum, Baltimore in partnership with The Ringling. With

over 160 objects, this major exhibit features many items on loan from museums around the world including the Metropolitan Museum of Art, the Victoria and Albert and the Louvre. The exhibition brings together sacred and secular art that is truly a feast for the senses.

At this special Penn Club cultural program experience all that The Ringling has to offer. After the tour explore the beauty of The Ringling grounds and gardens.
